PARK FEE The Death Valley National Park Service charges \$5 per car to enter the park, payable at Stove Pipe

Wells Park Service building. This fee is <u>not</u> included in the registration fee.

SUPPORT This event will be fully supported with several rest/refreshment stops – Town's Pass (starting at 7:30),

Panamint Springs, Father Crowley's Point, Keeler, and Darwin – a sweep vehicle, and lunch – from 1 to 4 PM – at the park in Lone Pine (next to Carl's). In addition to these amenities, all riders will receive a fabulous Tour de Death Valley T-shirt and a LIVESTRONG wristband; which will be distributed at the park in Lone Pine on May 14 from 1 to 4 PM. Day 2 will feature a water stop at the beginning of the portal road switchbacks and a rest/refreshment stop at the main portal road switchback (starting at

8:30).
